- ColdFusion Quick Reference Guide to CFML (no longer in print, but still handy to jog my memory a bit)
- [Regular Expressions in 10 Minutes](#) (Forta strikes again!)
- [SQL Pocket Reference](#) (perhaps the least used of the bunch, but I still like to have it)
- [The Elements of Style](#) (I don't write the copy, but it has still been handy)

These books taken together weigh less than a pound and take up less space than your average computer book. They have still managed to be tremendously useful when I am working on the road (especially if I am trying to get some work done with no internet connection).
